

Before Your Exam

- Schedule your exam using the link inside your NCARB Record
- Have your Photo ID ready (note: Military IDs and Credit Cards are not allowed)
 - It must be a government issued ID with a photo and signature
 - The first and last name on your ID must match the first and last name in your NCARB Record
- Make sure you comply with the exam rules provided by NCARB
- Review video walk-through of the testing experience
- Online Proctoring Technical Requirements
 - **Operating System**
 - Windows 8.1, 10 (Not 10s or 10 in s mode)
 - MacOS X10.13.6 or higher (New OS supported within 30 days of release)
 - **Screen Resolution**
 - 1368 x 769 or higher (PSI's minimum recommended)
 - 1920 x 1080 (NCARB's recommended)
 - **Bandwidth**
 - Minimum 300kbps (PSI minimum recommended)
 - Minimum 3mbps (NCARB's requirement)
 - **Camera & Mic** - Must be functional and available for testing. Camera must be external and include auto focus capability.

Make sure your testing space is quiet and free from clutter




Make sure your testing space is private, so no one interrupts you during your test.



You will **conduct a room scan** during online check-in.

This will consist of a 360° pan around the room. Then you will take a video of the space under your desk or table, and under your laptop or keyboard and mouse.



The online proctoring software will **detect your face** throughout your exam session.

When the system can successfully detect you, a green circle will appear around your face, onscreen.

Sometimes, the system will not recognize your face even if you are sitting in front of your webcam. Many things can cause this to occur:

- Poor Lighting (e.g., too dark, too bright, angled)
- Angle of Camera (e.g., webcam is not head on)
- Large or Reflective Glasses
- Long Hair (e.g., bangs covering your eyes)

For best results, position your camera and lighting directly in front of you:

2. Download PSI's Bridge Secure Browser

After clicking the launch link within your NCARB record, a PSI page will open and automatically download the Bridge secure browser. Open the downloaded file to initiate the installation process.

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




3. Install PSI's Bridge Secure Browser on your computer




4. Select the appropriate camera and microphone

This prompt may not appear if you have only one camera and one microphone.





5. A bandwidth check will run in the background

If you do not have sufficient bandwidth, you will receive the below message. You can try using a different computer, taking the exam in a different location, restarting your router or making sure others are not using excessive bandwidth on your connection.





6. Test your microphone by speaking out loud




7. A security check will prompt you to close any prohibited processes you currently have running according to your exam rules

You can close the programs immediately with the "Terminate this application" or close them manually before rechecking.

9. Take a picture of your Photo ID

Make sure your picture is visible and the name on the ID is readable. If the picture is unclear, you are able to retake the photo.


Photo ID Capture

Please take a picture of a current Photo ID.

- It must be a current, non-expired, government-issued identification.
- Military IDs are not currently accepted.

Photo Tips

1. Position the **FRONT** of your ID card in the center of the frame so that all of the corners are visible
2. Make sure that your photo is clear
3. Make sure that all of the text can be read
4. When you are ready, press the camera button




Captured Photo ID

Is the ID captured current and easily readable? If not, please click the red RETAKE button and capture your ID again. Otherwise, click CONTINUE

Photo Tips

10. Scan your room and workspace


Record a video with your webcam to show your desk area, floor, and the walls around you.

Scan Your Room and Workspace

Click the blue camera button and take a video of all four walls around your desk and your immediate workspace showing that you have no prohibited items within your reach. Click the red STOP button when you are done. Then, click CONTINUE.

Scanning Requirements

1. Room Scan should be slow and thorough. (Approximately 30-60 seconds)
2. Conduct a 360-degree scan all the way around the room.
3. Slowly scan from the ceiling to the floor.
4. Scan the entire desk/work-space area.
5. Scan the area directly underneath where you will be placing laptop and/or keyboard.
6. After your laptop or keyboard is in place, show your cell phone to the camera and place it directly behind your seat and out of reach.
7. Roll up any sleeves and show both sides of arms up to the camera.
8. Show your ears to ensure there are no earbuds in use.
9. If wearing glasses, hold them up to the camera for visual inspection.


11. Take a Selfie


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


12. Wait while you are connected to a proctor



13. Enter your exam within the Secure Browser




14. Complete your exam and submit your answers in the Test Driver




15. End proctoring session by clicking the “End Proctoring Session” button and confirm you want to permanently end your exam.
